RE: BILL WALTERS INQUIRY

Dear Mr. Dunlap:

During our September 13, 2006 telephone conversation I requested that Mr. Walters be provided access to all of your records, reports or interview transcripts to enable him to prepare for an interview that would be on equal footing. I understand that you will promptly provide the discs of records which you received from the City of Las Vegas (which you have been informed are public records) but declined to allow Mr. Walters to avail himself of any of the other relevant information which you have gathered. When we have received the records you agreed to make available and Mr. Walters has had the opportunity to thoroughly digest them regarding the transactions which span nearly a decade, Mr. Walters will determine his availability for an interview of himself and his employees.

Regarding your request for the private and, to an extent, confidential records of Mr. Walters and his businesses, you were not able to assure Mr. Walters of any confidentiality in his personal and business records nor could you provide any limits on their ultimate dissemination. Based upon my inability to find a legal basis for your authority to maintain confidentiality even if you had been so inclined, Mr. Walters followed my advice and will not waive his privacy and confidentiality rights by delivering records to your law firm. After reviewing the records you received from the City of Las Vegas, which we have thus far not had access to, Mr. Walters may provide records or information if supplementation seems necessary.
